BACKGROUND:

- 1. The Director-General of Licensing ("the Director-General") is charged with various functions under the *Liquor Act* ("the Act"), including the function of granting liquor licences to appropriate applicants.
- Katherine Regional Cultural Precinct Ltd (KRCP) has a Crown Lease 2405 for the premises known as Lot 3287, Town of Katherine, being 3 Maluka Road, Katherine East commencing 31 May 2013 and expiring on 30 May 2018 with a right of renewal.
- 3. By application dated 7 April 2017 KRCP applied to the Director-General for the grant of a liquor licence for the premises known as Godinymayin Yijard Rivers Arts & Culture Centre, and located at 3 Maluka Road, Katherine East.
- 4. The application listed the Directors of KRCP to be:

- The Act requires directors of applicant companies to undergo a probity examination including a nationwide Fingerprint and Name check for the stated purpose of a Liquor Licence and the provision of a National Police Certificate.
- 6. The applicant seeks only to provide the probity materials referred to in Clause 5 of this Undertaking for the following Directors:

7. Probity materials have been provided for the operational personnel in satisfaction of the requirements.

THE DIRECTOR-GENERAL'S CONCERNS

- 8. In assessing the application for the grant of a liquor licence the Act requires the Director-General, amongst other things to make an assessment of the character and general reputation of the officers of the body corporate. As several officers of the body corporate are unable to be examined as to their appropriateness to be associated with a liquor licence, it raises concerns as to the entity's appropriateness to hold a liquor licence.
- 9. The grant of the liquor licence to KRCP is subject to a pre-condition, offered in advance by KRCP, that KRCP enter into an enforceable undertaking, pursuant to section 72A(1)(b) of the Act to the effect that those persons listed in clause 12 of this Undertaking are restricted as to their involvement with the day to day operation and management of the business conducted under the liquor licence held by Katherine Regional Culture Precinct Ltd.

ACKNOWLEDGENT OF CONCERNS

10. KRCP acknowledges the Director-General's concerns and believes that they are reasonably held.

UNDERTAKING:

- 11. Under section 72A(1)(b) of the Act KRCP has offered, and the Director-General has agreed to accept, as an alternative to the Director-General refusing to grant the liquor licence to KRCP, the undertaking set out in this Enforceable Undertaking.

NON-COMPLIANCE

- 14. Should the Director-General believe that KRCP has failed to materially comply with the Enforceable Undertaking as described in clauses 15 and 16 she will write to KRCP setting out the concerns regarding non-compliance.
- 15. KRCP will have 14 days from the date of the Director-General's letter referred to in clause 17 to provide evidence satisfactory to the Director-General refuting the concerns, or that it has remedied such non-compliance.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

- 16. KRCP acknowledges that the Director-General, in accordance with section 72B of the Act, will record this Enforceable Undertaking in the Register of Enforceable Undertakings.
- 17. KRCP also acknowledges that the Register of Enforceable Undertakings may be inspected by any person, as required by section 72B(3) of the Act.
- 18. KRCP further acknowledges, in accordance with section 72A(3) of the Act, that it may vary or withdraw this Enforceable Undertaking only with the consent of the Director-General.

COMMENCEMENT DATE:

19. This Enforceable Undertaking will commence operative force from the date it is accepted by the Director-General.
